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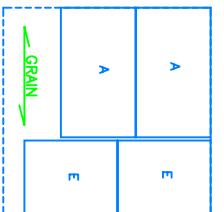
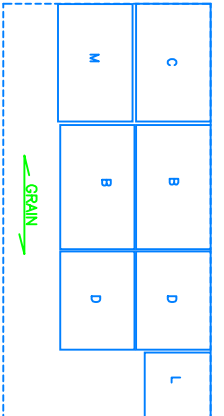
NOTE: Read all directions before beginning

Directions

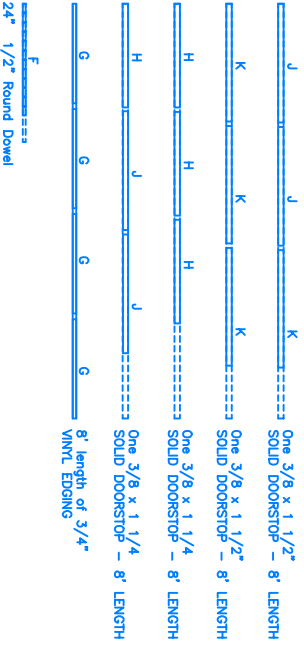
- 1) Lay out your material on the workbench, or on sawhorses, as outlined in the cutting diagram (Fig 1 and 2). Draw out all parts exactly as illustrated, including the letter designations, in pencil. Ensure to leave a small space between cut lines to allow for the width of the saw. Before cutting, double check all measurements to ensure they are correct. Always cut on the waste side of the line. To prevent splitting when cutting across the grain, we recommend that you use masking tape on the edge before cutting.
- 2) Drill holes through pieces E as shown (Fig 3), with a 1/2" drill bit, remembering that one piece is a mirror image of the other. Glue and nail E to D, leaving a 5/8" gap on the top and bottom, with 1" finishing nails. Repeat for the other DE assembly, creating a mirror image D/E one end each of the upper pieces E. 1/2" lengths of 1/2" dowel are to be fixed in position to allow C to slide back and forth, but not to come out once pieces K are attached. The other holes are for pegs F, to support shelf M at varying heights.

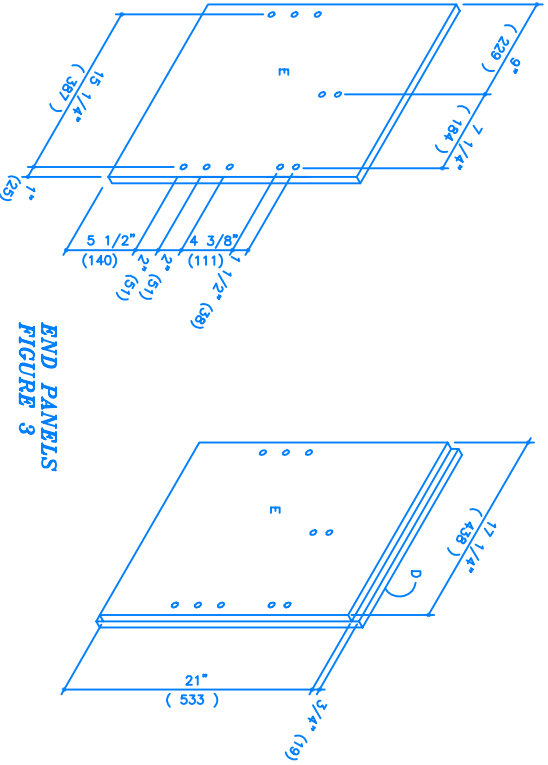


One sheet 3/4" PLYWOOD

One half sheet 3/4" PLYWOOD

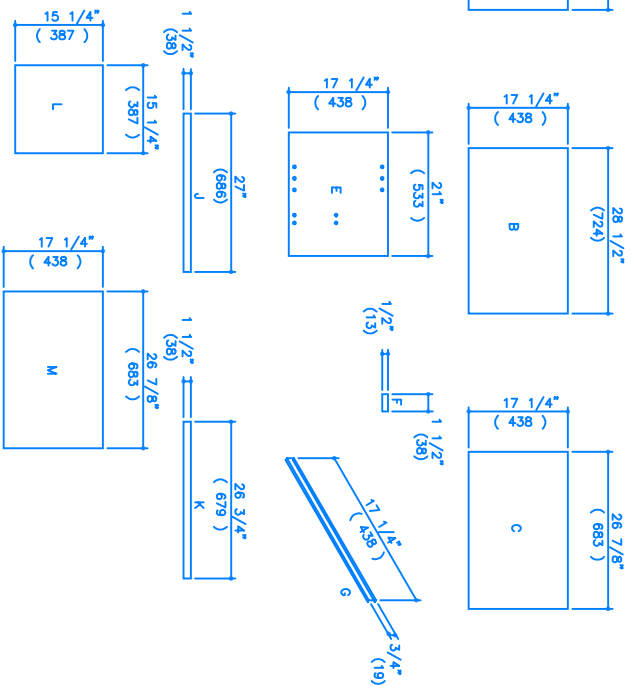


MATERIALS LAYOUT

MATERIALS LIST

- Approx. 1 lb. 2 1/2" nails
- Approx. 1/2 lb. 1 1/2" finishing nails
- Approx. 1/2 lb. 1" finishing nails
- Interior enamel paint
- One 4x8 sheet 3/4" plywood
- One 4x4 sheet 3/4" plywood
- Four 8' doorstop (3/4"x1 1/2")

MATERIALS LIST

- 8" vinyl shelf edging
- One lazy susan hardware (Optional)
- Four casters & hardware (Optional)
- One 8' length Edgetape (for stained project)
- Approx. Thirty 5/8" #8 flathed screws (Optional)
