

- into N. Givé and screw pieces M to N with eight 2 1/2" flothead screws. Ensure that the frame is square and set aside for give to set for two hours. Repeat for second door. After they have set and dried, insert and give 1/4" dowel plugs into the countersink holes. Cut and sand the plug smooth. Place the hinge and doorframe into the cabinet to dry fit for clearance, you may have to trim the door slightly. Insert the glass panels and attach each panel with eight positic screen clips. Attach the handles according to manufacturer's instructions. Attach the handles according to manufacturer's instructions. Attach the place of the door.
- 4 Build a simple box with pieces G and F as shown (Fig 5). Give and noil pieces F to G with 1 1/2 'finishing noils. Ensure the box is square, give and noil on piece U with 1 'finishing noils. All edges should be flush. Wipe off excess give. Place four dabs of give an piece L and attach to the box ensuring that it is square and centred. Noil 1" noils through G into L. Attach drawer pull, you may have to countersink through G. Attach the side mount drawer guides to pieces F and W, most hardware comes with instructions, follow them carefully. The drawers are sized to use 1/2" sidemount hardware.
- 5 Assemble shelves as shown (Fig 6) by gluing and nailing pieces S to pieces D and E with 1" finishing nails. Give and nail on pieces Q and R with 1" finishing nails. If using bnotwood, pre-arill pilot holes in shelves to prevent splitting. Wipe off excess glue.
- 9 Attach piano hinges and handles to doors K the same way you did in step 3. Install the doors by screwing the other side of the piano hinge to pieces A. Ensure the doors swing properly. - ح lron on edge lape (Illustration 2) on edges of A, K, J, and B. Sand and finish with your choice of stain and vanish, or oil. Insert shelves using the shelf brackets. 


