



You may wish to substitute the tentest or homascle with a section of carpet. If you select to do this, we suggest that you use a low pile carpet such as indoor/outdoor or commercial carpet. The low pile will allow you to install the dart board on top of the carpet without any unnecessary complications, whereas a high pile may inderfere with the installation of the board due to the thickness and softness of the carpet.
