





Lay out your material, as outlined in the suggested material layout (Fig 1). Draw out all parts exactly as illustrated, in cutting diagram (Fig. 2), including the letter designations, in pencil. Ensure to leave a small space between cut lines to allow for the width of the saw. Before cutting, double check all measurements to ensure they are correct. Always cut on waste side of the line. Wipe off any excess gliue at each stage of the project. To cut butt and barrel pieces A and E, lay out the grid as shown (Fig. 3) and free hand transfer to a thin piece of paper. Cut the paper and lay onto the pieces. Trace around the cuts and cut with a jigsaw. We recommend that you apply masking tape around the edges of the cutouts before cutting to reduce splintering.



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


Stand assembly BDEF on a flat surface. Lay a bead of glue along the outside edges and attach the two pieces 6 with 2" finishing nails. Note: if you mark pieces 6 on the outside with a light penal line 3.5/8" from the bottom, you can nail on this line and not miss piece E. Glue the edges of the CA assembly and nail through 6 into C as shown (Fig 4) with 1,1/2" finishing nails. Ensure the assembly is 1/4" below the top edge of G.

Predrill all nail holes if solid stock is used rather than plywood.

Stand pieces D and E on their back edges, lay a bead of glue along their edges, and nail on piece F with 1 1/2" finishing nails. Measure 1/2" from the top of B on both sides of the back and draw a line across. Measure 1/4" from the bothom of B on both sides of the back and draw a line across. Lay a bead of glue along the back of D and E, and lay on piece B with the marks flues with the top edges of D and E. Nail on piece B with 1 1/2" finishing nails. By nailing 3/8" below the line, you should not miss piece D or E. Wipe off excess glue, ensure and nail piece C to A with 1 1/2" finishing nails, ensuring tensuring that the edge of C is 1/4" above the top of A.

Set all nails, fill holes with wood putty. Edge tape should be applied to edges of phywood if project is to be stained. Sand project. Point or stain and varnish project. It is a good idea to install two eye holts in pieces 6 so that you can run a chain between them, and through your trigger guards, to lock up your weepons.




EXPLODED VIEW

This project, if it is to be painted, may be made with a scrap piece of good both sides plywood. If you will be staining and vamishing, adding edgetape to the project is recommended. All nail counts are approximate.
